Turkey Dinner Give Away

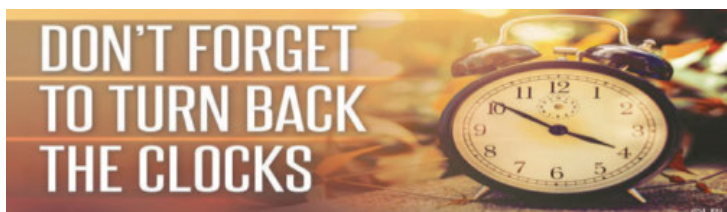

Sacred Heart Parish Mission

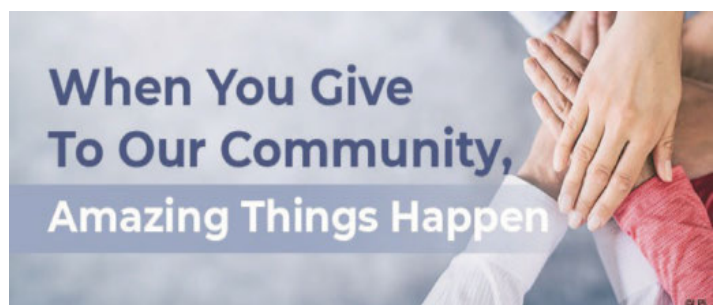

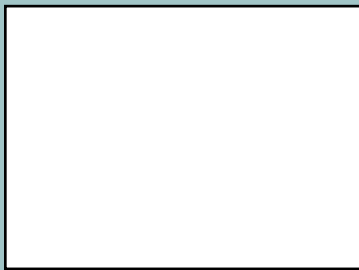
